- Further reduce airport until cost to airlines through increased capacity.
- Reengage network carriers from lower cost platform.

- A new route from a network carrier verse adding a low cost carrier.
- If an additional international options benefit ERI.
- Lowering cost per enplaned passenger to assist with securing a low cost carrier.
