Jack Bendig shared that Chautauqua County Airport is holding a shindig for the eclipse; it is going to be a big thing.

Visit Erie Eclipse Presentation

Chris Temple of Visit Erie shared information about the upcoming eclipse on April 8, 2024. She provided website information, a timeline, events, apparel, hotel reservations, and viewing areas/advice.

**Approval of Minutes:**

# **Committee Reports**

<u>Finance Committee</u>- Finance Committee Member Ryan Bergquist stated that the Finance Committee met on February 27, 2024. The cash forecast, December and January financials, bills to be paid, and expense reports were reviewed. Mr. Bergquist stated that the Finance Committee recommends approval of the bills. Brian Slawin made the motion to approve; seconded by Erin Kerner. Approved by Yeas: Aaron Susmarski, Erin Kerner, Eric Rogers, Brian Slawin, Dorothy Smith-Frazier, and Ryan Bergquist.

Financial Report- James Pacansky reported a deficit of \$107,484 for the month of December bringing our year to date deficit to \$151,019. We are unfavorable to budget \$403,709 with revenue unfavorable \$528,814 and expenses favorable \$125,105. Mr. Pacansky reported a deficit of \$61,192 for the month of January bringing our year to date deficit to \$61,192. We are favorable to budget \$54,251 with revenue unfavorable \$6,757 and expenses favorable \$61,008. Mr. Pacansky explained that paint, de-icer, and fuel are expenses that will tap into the funds on the favorable side. After a question from Ms. Kerner, Mr. Pacansky explained that we top off our fuel at the start of the winter season and purchase more as needed. After a question from Mr. Slawin, Mr. Pacansky explained that we will be meeting with Erie Bank soon to discuss options for our excess funds.

Mr. Slawin stated that Harmonic is working on the results of the survey conducted about the airport.

There was no Unfinished Business, no Resolutions, and no New Business.

#### **Liaison Comments**

Charlie Bayle of Eric County Council, District 6 introduced himself and stated he appointed Eric Rogers. He reported that he met with Derek Martin this morning for an overview of the airport. Mr. Bayle stated that he also toured North Coast Air. He added that he has a daughter in aviation and knows Dave Benson. Eric City Council liaison Chuck Nelson was also in attendance.

## **Board Member Comments**

Mr. Slawin shared that Dave Benson's Fundamentals Flight Training recently received national recognition from AOPA for "You Can Fly Distinguished Flight School Award". Also, Gannon University recently announced its brand new aviation program in partnership with Fundamentals Flight. This is in additional to the partnership already established with PennWest (Edinboro). In response to a question, Mr. Benson stated that they usually have 8-10 students per semester. The same amount is expected of the Gannon program.

## **Executive Director's Report**

Mr. Martin reported on the following:

- The airport will be participating in a coordination meeting with the FAA and North Coast Air regarding logistics of private aircraft arriving for the eclipse.
- He and Mr. Giannelli attended an air service roundtable in Savannah last week. Nine airlines were present at the routable.
- On February 27, 2024 a public meeting was held regarding air service development. Our consultant from Ailevon Pacific presented. A private meeting at Gannon was held earlier in the day for Erie City and County Council members as well as other elected officials and invited members of the private sector.
